We are only accepting applications for **produce, plants, and prepared foods** (prepared offsite and packaged to take home).

The reasons are:

- ◆ As has always been the case - We are a produce-based market and our parent organization, the Sustainable Agriculture Association of the Bear River Area's mission is to foster Sustainable Agriculture - therefore we need to make sure we have room for produce vendors when produce season starts.
- ◆ We are approaching the maximum number of vendors we as a volunteer organization can manage.
- ◆ We are at capacity of sales for crafts when considering the number of customers at the market
- ◆ We have numerous vendors selling very similar items and are continuing to receive requests to sell more of the same
- ◆ For crafts, we are concentrating on high quality artisanal items that will attract more customer to the market. And feel the best way to do this is for us to find and invite these people to become vendors.

OTHER SEASONAL: I am enclosing **\$175** (Includes \$10 application fee). (DEADLINE: April 1, 2010)

JUNIOR VENDOR (**12 and under**): The \$1 fee allows one small, wagon-load of produce **ONLY** no refills allowed. Violators will lose J.V. status and must pay regular Weekly Vendor fees for remainder of 2010 season. No application fee.
